**NOTICE COVID 19 OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES
IN WORKPLACE 16(2)**

COVID-19 COMPLIANCE OFFICER

In terms of Regulation No 669 Published by the Minister of Sport, Arts and Culture on the 11th of June 2020 (6F), Sports bodies must appoint compliance officers in writing before any resumption of training and matches to ensure compliance with these Directions in order to prevent the Spread of COVID-19.

Your duties will include:

1. Assist in the development and implementation of the SAWF operational plan for the phased return of its athletes, officials, and support staff to training and competition;
2. Overseeing of the adherence to hygiene and health protocols relating to COVID-19 at sporting venues utilised by the SAWF and its members;
3. Supervising the club safety with regards to Covid-19;
4. Ensuring that all measures are undertaken to ensure the safety of members, officials, support staff, employees and athletes;
5. Ensuring that the only registered members of the SAWF who have met and complied with the health protocols implemented by the SAWF with regards to screening and monitoring before, during and after training sessions.

You are reminded that you are required to be conversant with all relevant statutory provisions and regulations of the Occupational Health and Safety Act

(85 of 1993) as well as the Disaster Management Act 2002 (Act 57 of 2002) with relation to the health and safety of members participating in the sport of wrestling.
