We would like to inform you with regards to abovementioned scheduled National training camp.

Due to the current high Covid-19 infection rate that started during the festive break and continued after people returned from their destinations, we decided to minimise the risk to wrestlers by limiting exposure. The training sessions will only be on **Saturday 23 January 2021 from 08:00 – 13:00** at Primrose Wrestling Club.

We will continue our normal training camp schedule after the National trials on the 6 February 2021. Please take in mind that we will have to adjust to the Covid-19 regulations and ensure that we minimise the risk exposure for wrestlers, coaches and officials.

We will follow the normal Covid-19 protocol on Saturday, please note that no spectators are allowed in the venue. we asked that parents make the necessary arrangements in this regard.

All National training groups across the country must comply with the current Covid-19 requirements as set out by the SAWF.

The following requirements will be applicable:

1. Wrestlers must bring their own individual equipment and provisions like, water and energy drinks and light snacks.
2. Given the current circumstances with Covid-19 the National training sessions will be limited to wrestlers in age groups that may be considered for international participation for during 2021.
3. Online, Covid-19 screening will be ready in the next couple of weeks, for now screening will be done as required by the SAWF. We ask the minor please bring the signed screening form with them.
4. Please note no spectators will be allowed to attend the training sessions until the National regulations are amended.
