3. WEIGH-IN / MEDICAL: 06:30 – 07:15 AM

- Officials will meet at 07:15 for official meeting
- All wrestlers that entered must be registered on ETMS
- All wrestlers will be weighed after medical was completed







- All referees, team managers, administrators and coaches must be entered on ETMS
- No weight categories will be wrestled, all brackets will be done on the Open Brackets system with a 10% weight gap; bracketing will be done on ETMS after scales closed,
- Gold, Silver, and bronze medals will be awarded for the first three places for all categories
- Medals will be handed out on the Podium
- Only withdrawals with medical certificates, after entries has closed, will be refunded
- Late entries will be accepted - R50 additional charge per late entry
- We will allow female wrestlers to compete in male categories should they wish to do so
- Ringworm will be covered up as per the SAWF rules and regulations, with a R50.00 strapping fee
- Referees, medical staff, and tournament administrators will receive a meal and water during the day
- All matches will be live streamed

#### 4. TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Please keep traffic conditions in mind in and around the venue to ensure that you arrive on time – no wrestler will be allowed to weigh in after the official weigh-in has ended.
- Referees and Judges must report before 06:30 and immediately after weigh-in a short, compulsory, information session and rule discussion will take place.
- All wrestlers must be correctly registered with the SAWF through ETMS.
- All entries must be done on ETMS before the final closing date.
- Entries on the day of the competition will only be accepted from the head team manager. – R50 Additional per late entry
- Entry fees are non-refundable except in the case of withdrawal for medical reasons - medical certificates are to be submitted to the tournament secretary BEFORE the end of the official weigh-in.
- All referees, judges, team managers, coaches, HSS officials, and tournament administrators must be entered on ETMS before the final closing date.







- All delegates must register by scanning their barcoded membership card at the designated scanning point.
- Weigh-in and officials' cards will only be handed to the team manager.
- The Team manager is responsible for the withdrawal of wrestlers - for any reason
- Querying results or pairing/program errors - please note this is to be done at the Team Manager's station and not directly with the tournament administrators.
- Late entries of wrestlers or officials on the day of competition with the tournament secretary – with permission from the association's secretary general or president.
- Signing off final entries after weigh-in at the tournament administrator - changes after the start of the competition cannot be made.
- Officials are only allowed to participate in one role during the competition eg. Only as a coach or team manager and not both.
- The medal will be handed out after the finals and wrestlers must be present to receive their medals.

#### 5. SAWF MEDICAL RULES APPLY – POTENTIALLY INFECTIOUS SKIN LESIONS

- The purpose of the pre-competition medical check is not to eliminate wrestlers from competition, but the SAWF rules obligates us to ensure the health and safety of all participants during competitions.
- To decide if a lesion is infectious or not can be very difficult. For this reason, the opportunity to present a letter from a Dermatologist is accepted, to certify activity or non-activity of suspicious lesions.
- The letter from the Dermatologist should not be older than seven (7) days and must state where the suspected lesion / mark is and confirm that it is not infectious and has been treated.
- This letter must be handed in to the medical examination officials at the pre-competition examination.
- If no letter is submitted the medical practitioner or, in the absence of a medical practitioner, the HSS Council member on duty will apply the rules regarding the strapping of skin lesions, keeping in mind that the safety of other participants at the competition is priority.
- Only HSS approved strapping will be used to cover and secure the lesion - the cost of which will be passed onto the club by the tournament treasurer.





**NO WRESTLER WITH SKIN LESIONS OR CONTAGIOUS MEDICAL CONDITIONS IN AND AROUND THE FACE AS WELL AS THE NECK OR HAIRLINE WILL BE ALLOWED TO WRESTLE.**

- It may occur that a lesion was not seen during the pre-competition medical, for various reasons. The main reason often is that the wrestler has hidden the lesion by applying make-up to it. Should the lesion appear through the day the above guidelines will be apply.
- In the event of a dispute the senior team manager may request the tournament secretary to convene a panel consisting of the tournament secretary, SAWF refereeing delegate, the SAWF HSS delegate and the SAWF coaches delegate to rule on the matter - their decision is final, and no further representations will be considered, and no refunds will be given.
